RE: Storm Water Compliance

Well here we are with the start of the New Year!!! I just want to let everyone know that The City of Dickinson will be out throughout the year making sure that all the construction out there is in compliance with our Storm Water Permit. To do this we will be out checking the following from all construction projects that are greater than 1 acre.

- Notice of Intent from the State Health Dept.
- Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) from the State Health Dept.
- Inspection Records from (SWPPP) are kept up to date
- Cover letter from the State Health Dept.
- General Permit NDR10-0000 from the State Health Dept.
- Storm water Permits for the City and State
- Established construction site access (properly stabilized)
- Observed Trash
- Evidence of soil erosion or deposits on and off site
- That (BMP) Best Management Practices are being used
- Storm Drain Inlet Protection [Installed/Maintained]
- Records of spills and leaks

Off site tracking: Make sure to keep the streets clean to avoid complaints
